Cherokee Christian BYOD Requirements

Secondary School students are required to participate in the BYOD (Bring Your Own Device) program.

Typical BYOD Activities:

- Installing and Using the school-provided Microsoft Office suite
- Using our online learning platform, Schoology
- · Web browsing, Email

APPROVED Devices:

- Windows 10¹ or Apple MacBook² laptops are the best experience
- Recent Apple iPads³ are an acceptable choice. Students should get a keyboard⁴ case.

NON APPROVED Devices:

- · Android-based tablets
- Google Chromebooks⁵
- · Kindle, Kindle Fire
- Smartphones (Android/Google or iPhone)

Special Requirements for Students in Masterwork Studios

- There are not any additional BYOD requirements for Masterwork Studios.
- Students heading into their senior year should consult their program advisor to see if they would be better served with additional equipment.

Special Requirements for Students in STEM

- Students in the STEM program will need either a MacBook or Windows PC to run programming tools, analysis software, and web-based technologies.
- iPads are not acceptable devices for STEM.
- A laptop model with at least 8GB of RAM and an SSD (Solid State Drive) is highly suggested.

¹ Purchasing the cheapest Windows PCs (typically <\$300) can be regrettable. Look for a minimum of 8GB of RAM and 256 GB of Hard Drive space. Windows S mode is not supported at Cherokee Christian Schools.

² Any newer MacBook will work well. bhphotovideo.com and Apple Education sales sometimes have deals. Used MacBooks can be an option.
