



## Primary School Boys (Grades PreK-6) UNIFORM POLICIES FOR 2023-2024

Cherokee Christian Schools has chosen to adopt a uniform-based dress code for all grade levels. While we strive to align our overall policies with CCS values, we understand that there is often room for interpretation. Particularly with items not issued by one of our approved uniform suppliers (socks, shoes, belts, etc.), we allow as much individual expression as possible. However, we reserve the right to deem certain colors/styles as inappropriate for school uniform compliance. In order to serve as broad a community as possible, the school determines the dress code. Disagreement with the particulars of the dress code is not a valid reason for disobeying it. It is the responsibility of the parent to see that their child is dressed appropriately and in full accordance with the school's policies.

### General Standards

- Students are to be in uniform at all times while on campus during the normal school day.
- **All uniform pieces from our approved vendors must have the CCS logo.**
- All uniform clothing shall be neat, clean and in good repair. All clothing is to fit properly. Tight clothing or overly loose/baggy clothing is not allowed. Undergarments shall not be visible.
- **PE uniforms are required in Secondary School only.**

<b>HATS</b>	No hats are to be worn inside the school during school hours.
<b>HAIR</b>	Neat and clean. Hair shall not extend past the middle of the ear or touch the eyebrows. No hair coloring or bleaching.
<b>JEWELRY</b>	Limited to small rings, watches, wristbands, and one small necklace.
<b>COSMETICS</b>	None allowed.
<b>TATTOOS</b>	None allowed.

**Uniform Requirements:** *The interpretation of the code is left to the discretion of the administration. If a student is out of dress code, parents will need to bring a change of clothing.*

<b>BOTTOMS</b>	<p><b>Pants:</b> Blue denim jeans or standard uniform slacks (pleated or flat front) in Khaki or Black.</p> <p><b>Shorts:</b> Blue denim or standard uniform shorts (pleated or flat front) or active chino in Khaki or Black.</p> <p><b><i>All bottoms must be modest in fit and length. All bottoms must be worn at the hip or waist and have a hem. They must be solid in color and contain no holes or embroidery/appliqué designs.</i></b></p>
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<b>SHIRTS</b>	Collared polo shirt (short or long sleeve) in Black, Maroon/Burgundy, or Gray.  <b>Note:</b> Only white undershirts may be worn underneath uniform polos. NO long sleeve shirts may be worn underneath short sleeve uniform polos.
<b>SOCKS</b>	Conservative solid/printed socks with no objectionable content or images.
<b>SHOES</b>	Standard athletic or dress shoes suitable for P.E. No wheelies or flashing lights. No open-toed or backless shoes. No boots.

<b>OPTIONAL OUTERWEAR</b>	<b>Sweatshirt</b>	Crewneck sweatshirt in BLACK
	<b>Jackets</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Zip fleece jacket in Maroon/Burgundy or Black</li> <li>• Hooded zip-front sweatshirt in Black</li> <li>• Lined or unlined rain jacket in Black</li> <li>• Note: Hoodies are <b>not allowed</b></li> </ul>

**Note:** Only approved uniform outerwear may be worn in the classroom. Non-uniform outerwear may be worn during outdoor activities as needed.

## Spirit Day Standards

Most Fridays are designated as Spirit Day unless otherwise stipulated on the school calendar. Specific guidelines are listed below.

<b>BOTTOMS</b>	Standard uniform slacks, shorts or blue denim jeans/shorts. Bottoms must be worn at the hip or waist and have a hem. They must be solid in color and contain no holes.
<b>SHIRTS</b>	Any uniform shirt or sweatshirt with the school logo. Any school t-shirt sold at school functions, issued to students, or sold at the official CCS Online Spirit Store.
<b>SHOES &amp; OUTERWEAR</b>	Standard uniform code applies.
